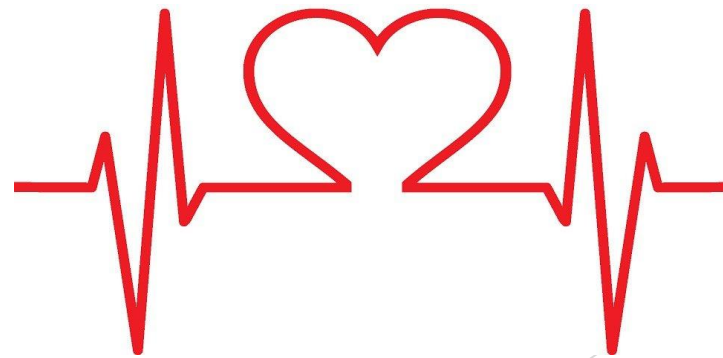

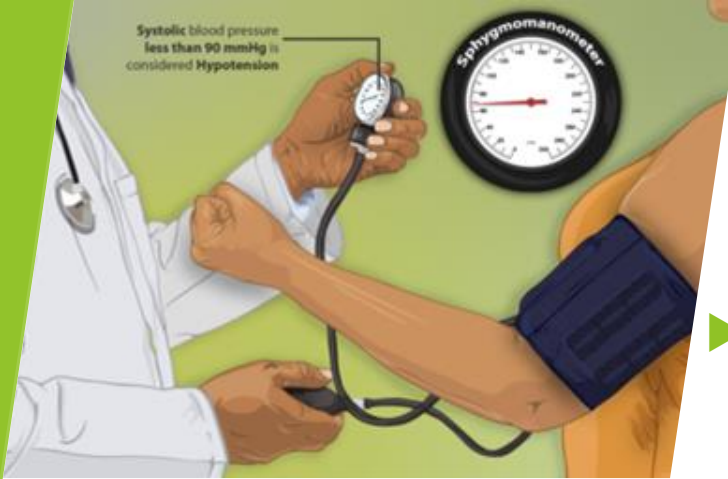

Club Overview

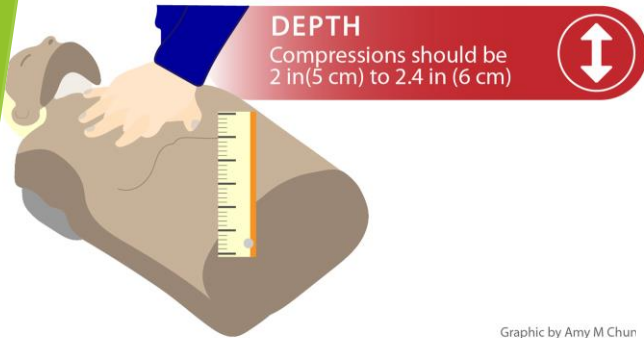

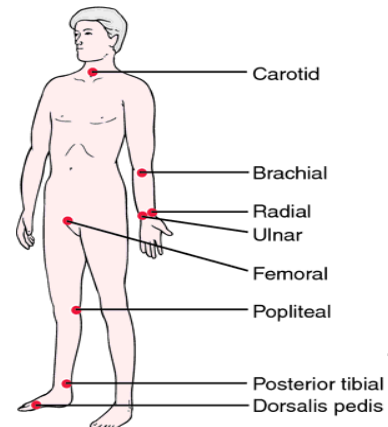


Clinical Skills
